
THIS COURT ORDERS that:

1. The Respondent Ashley Anne Legace is permanently restrained and enjoined from using the reserved titles “massage therapist”, “registered massage therapist”, “massage practitioner” or “registered massage practitioner” (collectively, the “Reserved Titles”), or any abbreviation of the Reserved Titles to describe her work, in association with or as part

of another title describing her work, or in association with a description of her work, as long as she is not a registrant of the College of Massage Therapists of British Columbia; and

2. The Respondent Ashley Anne Legace shall pay the costs of the petition to the College of Massage Therapists of British Columbia on Scale B.
